



Switchblock®, Rifles, Uppers, Barrel

Operation:

The locking detent on the Switchblock® must be depressed forward to adjust between the three settings. If the barrel is too hot to touch, use the tip of a projectile, or other pointed object to depress the detent. Rotate the drum to the desired setting.

The Switchblock® has three settings:

Normal:	Locking detent to the left
Off:	"O"
Suppressed:	"S"

Maintenance:

The Switchblock® is constructed of 17-4ph Stainless with a durable nitride finish. Do not lubricate the Switchblock®. If the Switchblock® is fired for an extended period of time in the same setting, carbon may bind the drum. In this case, use the supplied wrench to assist in rotation, while depressing the detent. It is recommended to switch through all the settings a few times after use.

BARRELS ONLY:

We recommend a pinned gas block for Military, Law Enforcement, and Self Defense use. Rifles, Uppers, and Barrels are available with a pinned Switchblock® for these applications.
